1. Official Participants

- Regarding construction of the official participants' pavilions, construction works by the Association for <u>Type Band Type C</u>) <u>pavilions have been completed.</u> There are nine structures in total, and the sections will be handed over to individual participants for interior and exterior design (for Type B) and exhibition content.

- July 11; The first handover of a Type B pavilion was made, to the <u>Kingdom of Jordan</u>. The theme of the pavilion is Weaving the Future and will introduce Jordan's longstanding history and culture. The main space will be built by cedar from Kamikitayama, Nara Prefecture, and will be covered with sand from the Jordanian desert. The space will be reused as a kindergarten after the end of the Expo.

2. Reports from the past week and plans for the upcoming week

- July 10; The Association and <u>All Nippon Airways (ANA)</u> will collaborate to hold <u>a stamp rally using NFTs (non-fungible tokens)</u> at three airports in Kansai region for a limited time. Three versions of NFTs will be distributed at Osaka International Airport (Itami Airport), Kansai International Airport and Kobe Airport. Those who complete the stamp rally at all three airports will receive a further NFT featuring a special airplane photograph.

* NFTs: Irreplaceable digital data created based on a blockchain which cannot be tampered with and cannot be transferred to another party.

- July 11; Mr. Masakazu Tokura, Chairman of the Japan Business Federation (also Chairperson of the EXPO Association), inspected the Expo site, including the Grand Ring and the progress of construction of the individual pavilions. Mr. Tokura expressed his view that the latest updates on the official participants' and other pavilions will help stir interest in the event, while also acknowledging the importance of construction proceeding safely and in schedule. Regarding advance ticket sales, he reiterated that the target of 14 million will be maintained given the rising interest.

4. Q&As

- Can we confirm that the number of Type A pavilions is now 47?
 - 1. As of July 11, following meetings and other interactions by the Association with the official participants, it has been confirmed that 52 countries are expected to participate with their own pavilions. Of these, 47 countries are planning to participate through Type A and 5 countries through Type X.
 - 2. In addition, 17 countries are planning to participate through Type B and 92 countries through Type C, for a total of 161 countries.
 - 3. Regardless of the format of participation, each participant will be doing its best to create an exhibit with a high level of originality. All relevant parties are working together to prepare the Expo to make it as attractive as possible to all visitors.
